Canvass of the November 5, 2013 Arenac County Election:

County Clerk Rick Rockwell administered oaths of office to Gail P. Schmidt (D) and Ardith Fales (R) and they were seated officially as appointed by Commissioners.

Chair Gail Schmidt called the meeting to order at 1:05 PM in Room 201 of the Arenac County Building in Standish, Michigan pursuant to public notice and the Michigan Open Meetings Act.

Present: Ardith Fales (R); Keith Rebischke (R), JoEllyn Pedota, (D), and Gail Schmidt (D). also County Clerk Rick Rockwell.

Whitney Township, Arenac County, Michigan (Tawas Schools):

Tawas Area Schools 18 mill Non Homestead Proposal: (2014-2013 inclusive):

The first item of business was the canvass of the Tawas Area Schools results from Whitney Township, Arenac County, Michigan.

Poll Book reflected that 53 voters cast ballots, the tabulator tape listed 53 ballots as being tabulated.

Tawas Area Schools Non Homestead Millage Totals: Yes: 28 No: 25.

Canvassers noted lack of certain notes explaining actions in poll book and that all paperwork on the back was not complete, but numbers matched.

This concludes the Canvass of the Township of Whitney (Tawas Schools). Canvasser's envelope was resealed. The above totals were confirmed.

Moffatt Township:

There were two township proposals on the Ballot as follows:

The Poll Book listed that 159 voters cast ballots on the following which matched the tabulator tape.

Renewal of Road Millage 2014-2018 (5 years):

Yes: 137 No: 22

Renewal of Mosquito Control and Suppression Millage (5 years):

Yes: 141 No: 17

All paperwork was in order and numbers matched. The Canvassers resealed their envelope and concluded the canvass of Moffatt Township. Election night totals were confirmed by the Canvassers.

Canvassers proceeded on to the Canvass of the City of Omer:

Canvass of the City of Omer:

The Canvassers opened their envelope noting that it was not properly sealed but did contain all information requested including a sample ballot. Poll Book indicated that 26 voters cast ballots and the tabulator indicated that 26 votes were tabulated. This concludes the canvass of votes of the City of Omer. Envelope was resealed. All candidates were declared elected. Election night numbers were confirmed.

Canvass of the City of Standish:

The Canvassers opened their envelope and all items were enclosed. The Poll Book indicated that 61 voters cast ballots and the tabulator tape indicated that 60 votes were tabulated but remarks indicated one provisional ballot which was not tabulated. Per City Clerk, voter was not registered in time for the election and she was issued a provisional ballot which the Clerk has determined will NOT be tallied and she has informed the voter as such.

It was moved by Gail Schmidt and seconded by Keith Rebishke to approve the Tawas Area Schools results of 28 yes to 25 no; Moffatt Township road Millage 2014-2018 one mill @ 137 yes to 22 no and Mosquito Control 2014-2018 one mill @ 141 yes to 17 no.; and further approve the results of the City of Omer noting all candidates ran without opposition and were declared elected. In Standish City, Mark Winslow, was declared elected Mayor; 2 year term; Daniel Couveau was declared elected to City Council for a 4


year term. Tosha Tunney was declared elected to City Council for a 4 year term; and Raymond Koroleski was declared elected for a 4 year term.
