1. One and Two Family Dwelling Total Heating /Cooling Input Rating Greater than 375,000 Btu Pr Hr
2. Alterations and Repair work determined by the Mechanical Inspector to be of a Minor nature.
3. Business, Mercantile, and Storage Buildings having HVAC only, with one fire Area and NOT more than 3,500 Sq.Ft.
4. Work Completed by a Governmental Subdivision or State Agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

Instructions for Completing Application

General: Mechanical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Iosco County Building & Safety Department. Work started before issuance of permit, will result in double of permit fees. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Mechanical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED. THE CHARGE TO RE-OPEN A CLOSED PERMIT IS \$50.00
