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ATTENTION VISITORS

The Iosco County Trial Court continues to maneuver through the COVID-19 Crisis and will make public updated policies as they change. To that end, we will strive to make our hearings available to the public by allowing persons to attend court hearings under strict guidelines as directed by the State of Michigan.

For persons who wish to attend or observe court as part of the general public, please note that our dockets will be published on the iosco.net website and on the Iosco County Trial Court's (governmental organization) Facebook Page. If you wish to attend public hearings, you will need to complete a screening and the form prior to entering the courthouse. Your information on the form must be no longer than one hour old. You will also be required to enter wearing a face mask or appropriate face cover prior to entry so please plan accordingly.

The required screening form may be found on the Iosco County webpage at iosco.net. You are signing the form as truthful under the penalty of perjury.

Please know that we can have no more than ten persons in the courtroom (including staff) so you may be asked which hearing or hearings you wish to attend.

Seating in the courtroom will be designated and monitored to make sure that we are all in compliance with the social distancing guidelines.

The remainder of the Iosco County Courthouse remains closed at this time. There will be no access to public restrooms or other offices within the building.

SCREENING FOR ON-SITE VISITORS

- Are you experiencing any of the following symptoms: fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, or diarrhea? Yes or No
- Do you have a fever today? Yes or No
- Have you had any close contact in the last 14 days with someone with a diagnosis of COVID-19? Close contact means a household member, or someone within six feet for ten minutes or longer. Yes or No
- Have you engaged in any activity or travel within the last 14 days which fails to comply with Executive Order 2020-21? Yes or No
- Have you been directed or told by the local health department or your healthcare provider to self-isolate or self-quarantine? Yes or No

A “yes” to any of the screening questions above requires the visitor to be:

- 3 days with no fever and 7 days since onset of first symptom, Yes/No
- 14 days since close contact of a diagnosed case of Covid-19 as described above Yes/No
- 14 days following an activity or travel as described in Executive Order 2020- 21 Yes/No

If you answered “no” to any of the three requirements above, please do not come to court. It is your responsibility to notify the court the reason for your absence if you were ordered to appear.
