Emergency Medical Service – Monthly Financial Report.

Scott Kiernicki, EMS Operations Manager, presented the financial report for the month of March, 2018. Two vehicles previously approved have been ordered and should be here within a month a two. The ventilator previously discussed was received free of charge through a grant and is operational. An additional ventilator would be ideal and would require funding to do so. Information only.

Administrator's Report.

School security – meetings have taken place with county school superintendents to propose a plan to provide officers in the schools by contracting with the Sheriff's Department. The cost for one officer to a school would be \$80,000 per year including the use of a vehicle. The proposal would require the school to enter into a three year contract. The idea of a county millage proposal was not recommended for various reasons including the school districts and boundaries not being completely within the

county. Schools would need to contact the county to make arrangements for the security officer.
