COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MINUTES August 7, 2019

Commissioners Present: Huebel, Dutcher, Finley, Mochring and O'Farrell.

Meeting called to order immediately following the full Board meeting.

Ralph Boudreau – Under Sheriff, Secondary Road Patrol – Grant Application.

Ralph Boudreau presented the Grant Application for the Secondary Road Patrol Program and after discussion a motion by Mochring with Dutcher supporting to recommend the full board authorize the chairman to execute the application as presented. All ayes, motion carried.

Trial Court Funding Commission Interim Report – Nancy Huebel, County Clerk.

The County Clerk, Nancy Huebel, presented the information found in the Trial Court Funding Commission Interim Report. A section in the report proposes a change to the Constitution with the elimination of the County Clerk's office from the Court System. After review and discussion a motion to recommend the full board go on record opposing altering the Constitution to provide that Circuit Court clerks are employed by the court and under the supervision of state government rather than the County Clerk. A motion by Mochring the Dutcher supporting to recommend the full board notice the Governor, Senators, Representatives and the Michigan Association of Counties of the opposition to the Trial Court Funding Commissions Interim Report. All ayes, motion carried.

Administrator's Report – Elite Shellenbarger:

Gypsy Moth Suppression Program – After several complaints from residents in the Long Lake, Chain Lakes and other areas in Plainfield Township regarding Gypsy Moths the committee received and reviewed a proposal from Aquatic Consulting Services, Sanford, Michigan. The proposal includes surveying properties to determine spray areas, treatment recommendations and spray coordination for Gypsy Moth caterpillars. After discussion a motion by O'Farrell with Finley supporting to recommend the full board contract with Aquatic Consulting Services as presented with the funds to be used from the Gypsy Moth millage leftover from previous years. All ayes, motion carried.

Building and Safety Department – 1997 Ordinance re: non-licensed builders and Financial Report.

Shellenbarger was approached by the Building Department to hire a code enforcement officer to enforce the 1997 Ordinance re: non-licensed builders doing roofing and siding with a license or permit. No action taken at this time.

The 2018 year-end financial report was presented and reviewed along with the current year to date report. Information only no action taken.
