JANUARY 20, 2021

### NEW BUSINESS:

Scott Kiernicki, Emergency Medical Service – Monthly report. Information only.

CPR devices, 3 AED's and 1 ambulance vehicle. After discussion a motion by

### Iosco Transit Corporation.

The committee reviewed the Project Authorization between the Iosco County Board  
of Commissioners and the Michigan Department of Transportation for the Iosco  
Transit Corporation FY 2021 Section 5311 Operating Program (CARES Act)  
funding. After discussion a motion by Moehring with Dutcher supporting to

### Parks and Recreation Commission.

The committee reviewed a recommendation from the Parks and Recreation  
Commission to appoint Jerry Smith to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term
