COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MINUTES (Held Via Zoom) JUNE 3, 2020

New Business:

L-4026 – Taxable Values sent to the State. Information Only.

Emergency Medical Service – Scott Kiernicki, request to purchase new ambulance and sell old.

Kiernicki presented a bid for a new ambulance from Mercy Sales in the amount of \$163,434.00. The cost submitted includes delivery, title work, graphics, inverter install, radio install, wireless install, driver monitoring install and programming. After review a motion by O'Farrell with Dutcher supporting to recommend the full board approve the bid as submitted. All ayes, motion carried.

Kiernicki further requests to sell the ambulance the new one replaces. After discussion a motion to authorize the sale of one ambulance as requested. All ayes, motion carried.
