b. Bike/Hiking Trail: Fred Lewis from Plainfield Township submitted a grant application to extend the shoulder of the road from 3 feet to 5 feet wide. The total project cost would be \$46,600. He is seeking a \$5,000 grant from the Parks and Rec Commission under the Safe Shoulder Program. Roll call vote to submit this Committees approval to BOC. 5 ayes, 1 abstention.

ORV Trails- Joel and Ken Foster reported Trail 649 South of Shellenbarger Road still needs improvements. Trail 6 still lacking gravel, will have to apply for a grant. Perhaps an ATV Grant could be applied for, but the P & R Commission would have to get approval from both the Forest Service and DNR for additional improvements. Blazer and K. Foster will contact the Road Commission about gravel.
