## COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MINUTES MAY 19, 2021

**Meeting called to order immediately following the full Board meeting.**

### NEW BUSINESS:

**Mike Eller. 911 Director – Central Wrecker Policy.** The request is to dissolve the Iosco County Towing/Wrecker Policy, adopted on September 21, 2016 by the Iosco County Board of Commissioners. The Iosco Central Wrecker Policy will be a Central Dispatch Policy managed and enforced by the 911 Director, like all other Iosco Central Dispatch policies. After discussion a motion by Dutcher with Finley supporting to recommend the full board dissolve the Iosco County Towing/Wrecker Policy with the understanding the 911 Authority Board will have their own policy for the 911 Dispatch Center, effective immediately. All ayes, motion carried.

### Scott Kiernicki, EMS Director – Monthly financial statement.

The committee reviewed the financial statement for the month of April. The information was accepted as presented. Information only.

### Sheriff Frank – Inmate Telephone and Commissary Contracts.

Sheriff Frank presented regarding the contracts for Inmate telephone and commissary accounts. The previous contracts expired and after researching providers the recommendation is to contract with CPC-Combined Public Communications for the inmate telephone services and Stellar Services for the inmate commissary provider. After discussion a motion by Dutcher with Huebel supporting to recommend CPC for the inmate telephone services and with a motion by Dutcher and Moehring supporting the committee recommends Stellar Services for the inmate commissary provider as presented by the Sheriff. All ayes, motions carried.

**Full-time road patrol deputy - vacancy.**

The Sheriff proposed hiring an individual for the full-time road patrol deputy position and requests to post and hire from within the department and send the employee to an MCOLES academy. The academy starts in August with a cost of \$7,884 and is currently in budget line #101-301-704.00. An agreement will be drawn up that the employee will pay the county back, for the academy, costs if the employee leaves within a certain time period. After discussion a motion by Moehring with Finley supporting to recommend this action to the full board for approval.
