Mike Eller and Eric Abbott, Emergency Management Update on "The Brittle Fire".

Mike spoke on shelters, radio's, emergency management, MSP and indicated this was a Federal event and handled by the forest service personnel. The all clear was given around 9:00 p.m. which allowed residents to return to their homes. Received donations of food and water and the feedback was very positive with few concerns which included notification for evacuations, some homeowners didn't hear the knock on door or they were downstate homeowners. Abbott added there were no injuries and no loss of structures, Abbott further advised of his participation with telephone and computer communications. Commissioner O'Farrell discussed capturing expenses incurred by the county as a result of this event and further requests a monthly or quarterly report from the EMC. Commissioner Dutcher was concerned that none of the County Commissioners were notified but the most important thing this is that the EMC team did what they needed to do.

The committee reviewed a request for the FY20/21 STING Appropriation and after review it was determined the funds were not approved in the 2020 or 2021 budget and therefore were not approved for payment.
