## COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MINUTES (Held Via Zoom) SEPTEMBER 16, 2020

### NEW BUSINESS:

#### Emergency Medical Service – Monthly financial report.

The August financial report was presented for review. The committee received an update of the Radio request, hired a full-time EMT and Paramedic. Information only.

**New Business:** Carla Grezeszak – Ottawa County Juvenile Detention Center Bed Rental Agreement with the 23rd Judicial Circuit Court. Carla explained the compensation and indicated the center is utilized approximately 2 to 3 times a year. Further the cost is to the Child Care Budget #292 with a 50% reimburse rate. After discussion a motion by O'Farrell with Finley supporting to recommend the full board approve the agreement as presented. All ayes, motion carried.

#### Gypsy Moth Funding request from Plainfield Township Trustee, Roger Houthoofd request to amend resolution.

The committee reviewed the request to amend the resolution regarding the fund balance in the Gypsy Moth Suppression Fund as submitted by Roger Houthoofd, Plainfield Township Trustee. The question, as to whether the resolution could be amended to change the direction mid-stream, was presented with a request to have legal counsel take a look at it. With a motion by Dutcher and O'Farrell supporting the issue will be presented for discussion at the full board with no specific recommendation. All ayes, motion carried.
